Pupils speak more highly of PE lessons, which has increased enthusiasm and engagement in lessons and therefore increased attainment across school.
How has your school's spending increased pupil PE and sport activity levels?	Funds have been used to provide additional opportunities at breaktimes and lunchtimes, through provision of equipment and a member of staff to train and lead sports leaders.
How has your school's spending increased school sport participation?	Funds have been used to deliver extra-curricular activities in school. Extracurricular clubs are full and pupils have enjoyed working with external providers. Funds have supported intra-school competitions and sports day for all children.

Funds have used to provide release time for the PE lead to attend meetings with the Gedling SGO and support members of staff in school.

Staff have set up and run clubs as well as attending events and competitions outside of school. Funds have been used to provide release cover to allow staff to attend sporting events and competitions during and after school.
